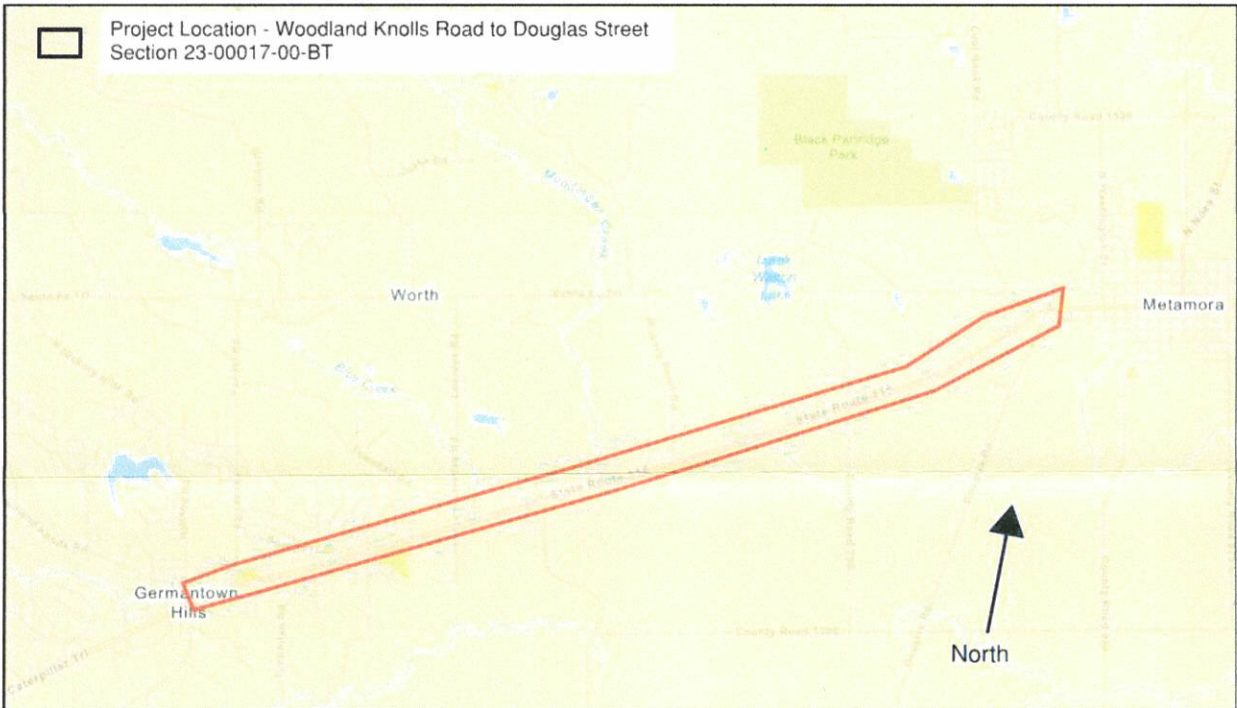


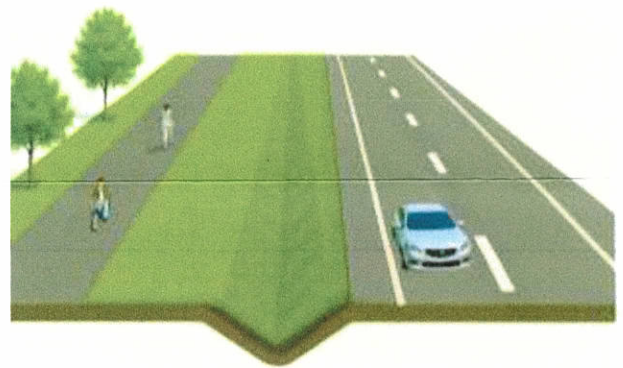
GERMANTOWN HILLS TO METAMORA TRAIL PROJECT



The Germantown Hills to Metamora Trail project aims to enhance regional connectivity and promote safe, accessible transportation options by constructing a 10-foot-wide asphalt trail along the north side of IL Route 116. This off-road multi-use trail will connect the communities of Germantown Hills and Metamora, addressing the current lack of pedestrian and bicycle accommodations along this corridor. The project scope includes the development of the trail itself, complemented by enhanced crosswalks at side roads to ensure safe crossings for users. The project's limits are from Woodland Knolls Road in Germantown Hills to Douglas Street in Metamora.

Construction improvements to the north side of IL 116 shall include the following:

- 10' wide asphalt multi-use path for pedestrians & bicyclists
- ADA-compliant ramps and new crosswalks at Fandel Rd, Arbor Vitae Dr, Lourdes Rd, Susan Ln, and Douglas Street
- New mid-block crossings with signage for visibility at Outback Ln, Hickory Pt Rd, Timber Oaks Dr, Riggert Rd, and Center Street
- Partial replacement of driveways



The Village of Germantown Hills and Village of Metamora will be seeking construction funding. Construction schedule is to be determined.
