

# IMPORTANT POSTMARK CHANGES

## What Vote by Mail Voters Need to Know



### Mail Postmark Rules Have Changed

**Previously:** Mail was postmarked the day you mailed it

**Now:** Mail is postmarked **the day it is processed** which can result in **at least a 1-2 day delay**

## VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS


Must be Postmarked by Election Day to be Counted

A late postmark will **NOT** be counted



### Mailing Your Ballot Close to Election Day?

If you are returning your ballot within a week of or on Election Day:



Go to the post office counter & request a **manual postmark**



Use a **secure drop box** (if available)



Deliver your ballot directly to your **election authority's office**

## DON'T RISK A LATE POSTMARK

Take one extra step to make sure **YOUR VOTE COUNTS!**

Check with your election authority for drop box locations and office hours
